Residential Construction Project Update

Pennsylvania's Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) has updated its guidance for businesses trying to get clarity on what they can and cannot do.

<u>DCED's FAQ page</u> – If you're in the residential construction business, Section 19 answers the question "**May I complete my customer's residential construction project?**"

ANSWER: General construction must be suspended but limited activities may continue to the extent necessary to stabilize the site, temporarily prevent weather damage and make emergency repairs.

While every builder and contractor will need to exercise their own best judgement based on the unique nature of their individual job sites, this answer gives some guidance for what you can do even if you do not have an approved waiver. Request your waiver today using the button below.

In all cases, you should practice the latest social distancing and COVID-safe work practices. You may also wish to consult your legal counsel regarding specific job site guestions.

We understand that there are still many unanswered questions, but this provides more information regarding abandoned job sites.

Regardless of whether you have a waiver, you should have a copy of the latest DCED guidance available while on any work site. If you have waiver approvals, we encourage you to ensure all employees, subcontractors, suppliers and local municipalities have a copy as well to avoid any further delays.
